For your child's safety, please do not send them to school with necklaces or high heeled shoes (e.g. dress-up shoes). I encourage children to bring a toy to school (not very expensive or very big) to help them feel comfortable.

To help minimize the spread of germs, we would request you to please do not send your child to school sick i.e. if your child has fever or green nose discharge. The best place for any sick child is at home where they are most comfortable.

I believe that a good parent-teacher relationship is necessary for your child's success. Throughout the year, I will be communicating through notes in the diaries, telephone calls, progress reports and report cards. We will hold parent and teacher conference twice in a year. However, if you have any questions or concerns during the year, please do not hesitate to contact me through the school or by making an appointment between 1pm to 2pm.

I hope to have a wonderfully joyous year with your child in my class and I hope to have a great relationship with you as parent. Together we can make this year, for your child a wonderful experience before they go on to the first grade. Best Regards,
