Classroom News

This month our theme is 'Growing and Plants'. We are exploring:

- How a seed can turn into a plant, i.e.: cress, beans, parsley, flowers, etc.
- What are fruits and what are vegetables?
- What seeds need to grow and what type of flower or fruit they produce?
- We are observing plants that come in different sizes and colors: big, small, short and tall.

The children will have the opportunity to plant different seeds in our classroom garden, water them on daily basis and learn how to take care of them.

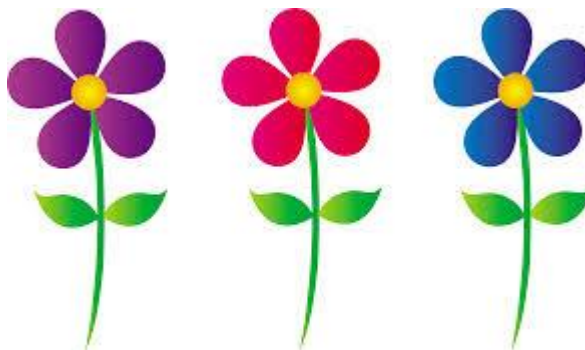
